**DETECTING DECEPTION -
Investigative Interviewing and Verbal Credibility Assessment**

This will be a "hands-on" workshop in which participants will gain knowledge and experience in interviewing and credibility assessment. The first portion of the day will involve learning and practicing interview techniques that enhance honest and accurate recall and protect memory from damage or distortion. The second portion of the day will involve learning to recognize and evaluate verbal behaviors indicative of honesty or deception. Attendees will be provided with a number of honest and deceptive interviews and taught how to recognize one from the other. The training will begin with written transcripts of interviews, then move to audio recordings and then to video recordings. Dr. Hiscock-Anisman and Dr. Colwell are recognized as international authorities on Interviewing and Detecting Deception, and their Assessment Criteria Indicative of Deception (ACID) system is the most promising and well-researched comprehensive approach to interviewing and credibility that exists. Unlike many researchers, they have carefully studied both how to detect deception and how to train professionals to use their techniques. Research has shown that ACID training is effective in increasing the ability of forensic professionals to detect deception, even when those professionals have had an average of 16 years of job experience (law enforcement, attorneys, psychologists, psychiatrists, judges, etc.).
