Basic Inmate Transportation

STC Certified (8 hours)

Tuition Not to Exceed \$113

This eight hour basic transport course is designed to provide students with the tools to take proactive steps to ensure their safety, as well as the safety of the public and the prisoner during inmate transportation. Preparing for inmate transport, intelligence gathering, route planning, equipment/vehicle check, inmate placement during transport, radio communication and hospital roles and responsibilities will be examined. Various types of transports, including court, medical, institution transfers, and emergency transports will also be covered. Students will also perform table top scenarios and vehicle search exercises during the course.

- Various types of inmate transports and the risks
- Special considerations when transporting:
 - Females, people with disabilities, high risk inmates
- Intelligence gathering
- Planning and mapping the route
- Equipment (restraints, weapons, safety)
- Checking and searching the vehicle
- Searching the inmate and inmate placement in the vehicle
- Identifying and minimizing common problems in inmate transportation
- Vehicle search drills

While in the training division, he supervised the Correctional Academy, Advanced Officer Training and the Detention Training Officer (DTO) program.
