DESCRIPTION:

This 8-hour course will provide the student with foundational knowledge on the history and concepts necessary for law enforcement personnel responding to active shooter, rapid intervention critical incidents. Topics will include history, team tactics, use of force, mindset of both officers and suspects, weapons use, triage protocols, legal aspects and incident management.
