- This is a 16-week Adult Corrections Officer Core Course consisting of 221 hours (10.5 semester units) of instruction in specific performance and instructional objectives for local and county jails, probation institutions and Community Correctional Facilities and federally funded private programs. This Course exceeds the minimum standards of the State of California, Board of State & Community Corrections (BSCC), Standards and Training for Corrections (STC) for entry level adult corrections officer.
- Corrections Academy topics include inmate supervision, criminal law, gang/inmate illegal behavior recognition, defensive tactics, physical conditioning, communication, drug awareness, professionalism and ethics, PREA, career development, correctional officer wellness, transportation of prisoners and much more!
