Course Description:

This course is an introduction to the Internet and the social media phenomenon. The class will address the more popular social media websites such as Facebook, but will also work with Craigslist and YouTube. Participants will be introduced to the online gaming community and how it is relevant and important to law enforcement investigations (Cyberbullying). The purpose of this course is to give law enforcement officers the tools needed to investigate crimes where Internet usage occurs and find leads associated with such occurrences. Investigators will learn about the many uses of undercover personas and accounts. At the conclusion, the student will also have an introduction to social media search and telecommunication search warrants.

The student will need to bring a laptop with Wi-Fi capabilities. If the laptop is a department laptop, please ensure that it can access the Internet with no restrictions.
