IRNIR is a two-day awareness-level course offered by the Defense Nuclear Weapons School (DNWS) to increase confidence and skill in responding to and mitigating the consequences of radiological accidents and terrorist weapons on mass destruction (WMD) events. The course covers command and control as well as life saving measures. IRNIR is listed in the FEMA National Training and Education Division State/Federal Catalog as course number DOD-001-COMM.

The target audience for this course includes all personnel who are expected to perform in a support capacity during an incident. This includes all multi-agency emergency response and incident command personnel.

This is a rare opportunity to attend this training in San Diego. RTC has partnered with the military to include law enforcement personnel in this course and provide POST credit. Registration for all non-military members will go through RTC.
