##### Building Resiliency in Law Enforcement Personnel

First Responders are routinely exposed to traumatic incidents and daily pressures that require a strong and stoic toughness of attitude and temperament. Without this tenacity, they couldn't do their jobs effectively. Sometimes, however, the stress and trauma that accumulates begins to impact their attitude, emotional resiliency and relationships. The culture that conditions law enforcement to be strong and stoic does not give permission for the normal human response to the tragedies to which they are exposed. Increasing resiliency means giving First Responders permission to experience normal human reactions and that, "It's ok, to not be ok." Using humor, personal and professional experience, Heather will bring awareness to how this work can impact us and will provide the tools needed to build resiliency on the job and in the home.

#### SESSION #2

##### Recruiting & Retention without Compromise

Law enforcement agencies need to understand the new climate of potential recruits and what it will take to attract qualified candidates, even if they don't resemble the recruits of the past. Examine the struggles agencies are having in recruiting Millennials (Generation Y and Generation Z) and how to attract, acculturate and learn from our Millennial applicants. It will go in depth into what they expect from a career in law enforcement and how agencies can temper their expectations with what can be offered. By recognizing the unique value proposition each agency possesses, and understanding how their brand can have an impact, agencies can accentuate the qualities of their organization that will draw applicants to their doors.
