The San Bernardino County Crisis Intervention Team (CIT) Training Program will highlight the collaborative partnerships that work together to help individuals experiencing a behavioral health crisis obtain appropriate services with the goal to reduce criminal justice involvement and acute psychiatric hospitalization. Specific elements will be highlighted that have been essential in the establishment of the CIT program in San Bernardino County. This includes the cultivation and continued enhancement of collaborative partnerships, the formation of a CIT committee, establishing linkages to crisis systems of care and programmatic supports, and building a network of subject matter experts that can serve as instructors and liaisons for first responders and behavioral health consumers.
