Currently, across the United States there exist thousands of use of force incidents where uniformed police officers are required to use the minimum amount of reasonable force to safely effect a lawful arrest. Unfortunately, many times during these incidents either the suspect or officer sustained unintended injuries. Additionally, the outcomes of these unintended uses of excessive force subsequently result in workers' compensation claims, degraded patrol capabilities and at times ultimately lawsuits.

For these reasons the detailed-practice and ongoing mastery of the submission martial art of Brazilian Jiu-Jitsu is a high percentage functional option that can afford police and sheriff's Offices an effective alternative to defensive tactics training POST academy. Finally, although a formal survey of chiefs was not conducted the presenter has conducted informal surveys over the past ten years which include instruction of police officers and sheriffs deputies in classroom instructional environments as well as attendance and completion of recent basic POST recertification course.
