

IMPAIRED DRIVERS APPREHENSION PROGRAM (IDAP) TRAINING

The Los Angeles Police Department presents a 40-hour, POST-certified, Impaired Drivers Apprehension Program course. This course includes instructional material certified by USDOT, NHTSA and the IACP. The students are instructed on the legal aspects of Driving While Intoxicated (DWI) enforcement, Detection of DWI drivers, the development and validity of DWI detection, instruction on how to conduct the Standardized Field Sobriety Test (SFSTs), and contains two controlled drinking practice sessions. Students are further instructed on report writing, how to prepare for trial and courtroom testimony, and there is a Moot Court. This also serves as the prerequisite to Drug Recognition Expert (DRE) School. This portion of the class provides instruction on DRE procedures, and overview of signs and symptoms of all seven drug categories (CNS Depressants, Inhalants, Dissociative Anesthetics, Cannabis, CNS Stimulants, Hallucinogens, and Narcotic Analgesics), drug combinations, and narcotics laws. This is a technical course and involves hands-on skills. This is taught by Certified DRE Instructors. Students will receive a NHTSA/IACP certificate and if they qualify the ability to apply for DRE school. This course is a pre-requisite to Drug Recognition Expert (DRE) School.
