**VETERAN & MILITARY INSIDER  
THREAT TRAINING PROGRAM**  
**(Coming in 2023) (8 Hours)**

Law enforcement who encounters Veterans and military personnel exhibiting threatening or hostile behavior in their communities should take this course. It will discuss assessing threats involving military/Veterans, historical incidents involving military personnel, military training/skills, gang/HVE concerns overview, case studies and management/intervention strategies.

**VETERAN CULTURE FOR  
SUPERVISORS & MANAGERS**

**(Coming in 2023) (4 Hours)**

Supervisors & managers who recruit and employ Veterans and military personnel in their communities and their organizations will benefit from this course. This course will help orient supervisors & managers on military and veteran culture, laws pertaining to veterans and servicemembers, understanding the mental health conditions that pertain to military service, skill sets that veterans bring to the organization and servant leadership and employee engagement strategies for veteran and servicemembers.



**RISK MANAGEMENT FOR

Veteran Peer Support Specialists who will be helping Veterans and military personnel out in their communities will benefit from this course. It will discuss risk assessment processes, risk mitigation steps, de-escalation of volatile behavior, personal safety, reporting of crimes and criminal activity, rapport building and tactical communication strategies. Introduction of Military Sexual Trauma and how that impacts military and Veteran personnel and resources available to assist VPAN Specialists with Veterans in crisis.


