## **Basic Instructor Course (IDI Level I)**

Presented by the **Government Training Agency**

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**Description:** This course is the foundational course for all instructors, including law enforcement, public safety dispatchers and professional staff. Students will apply adult learning methodologies and build skills in facilitation and presentation skills. Students will learn how different delivery strategies enhance student retention and understand their role and responsibilities as an instructor. This course is specifically designed for instructors teaching in-service, advanced officer training, or in the role of a field training officer/dispatch trainer.

This course is open to all local government personnel looking to increase their instructor skills, both in front of an audience and in the development of training materials.
