Course Content: This course is designed to prepare newly appointed Sergeants in the duties and responsibilities of a first line supervisor in a Law Enforcement agency. Students will be led through facilitated discussions exploring the various aspects of supervision as well as legal responsibilities associated with this new position.

Prerequisite: Appointed as a Supervisor with the agency.

Certification: This course is certified under POST reimbursement Plan IV. Class hours are mandated by POST and full participation is required for certification. Completion certificates will be awarded.

Tuition/Credit: 1.5 lower division semester units will be awarded for completion of this course. Tuition is \$69.00 per students.
