4.	POST Report	Training Products released this CPT Cycle - Learning Portal Updates (Training Mandates). PSP: Strategic Communications Course Update (4 CPT) Jan. 2026. Completions automatically transfer to CPT to the Training Profile in EDI; Domestic Violence Complaints (2 CPT) to be completed every two years; Elder/Dependent Adult Abuse (2 CPT) w/in 18 months of assignment to field or investigative duties; peace officer at a supervisory level and below; First Aid/CPR/AED/BLS (8 CPT) to be completed every two years; Hate Crimes Identification & Investigation (2 CPT) 2 hours required; Hearsay Testimony Proposition 115 (2 CPT) peace officers with specified training or five years of experience to provide hearsay testimony

		<p>during preliminary hearings; High Speed Vehicle Pursuit Training (2 CPT) 1 hour required, completed annually; High Technology Crime Training (4 CPT) every city police officer or deputy sheriff at a supervisory level assigned field or investigative duties, or w/in 18 months of assignment to supervisory duties; Human Trafficking (2 CPT) 2 hours required; Racial and Identity Profiling Update - Beyond Bias & Identity Profiling Update (4 CPT) 2 hour required to be completed every 5 years; and Terrorism Law Enforcement Response to Terrorism (8 CPT) 8 hours required Peace Officers and 1st Responders to terrorism incidents at Lt. level and below who are assigned to a field position. Public safety communications personnel.</p> <p>PC 832 course has been increased from 64 hours to 92 hours. Which covers arrest and control</p> <p>Backgrounds Update - Effective 2031 New Requirements bill specify that a bachelor's degree or an associate degree required for employment as a peace officer under these provisions may be obtained after completion of the POST Program and within 36 months of employment as a peace officer Education Bill AB 392 will require one of eight scenarios: If they have an associate's degree, or bachelor's degree they don't have to get the modern policing degree. If they have 8 years of military experience in good standing or 8 years of experience of law enforcement in another state (outside of CA) they don't have to get a modern policing degree. If they do not have any of the things mentioned they have three years to get it. They will have some credits applied from the police academy but would have to get another 9 credits afterwards. If they fail to get their modern policing degree, it is up to the agency what they are going to do with them. Possible actions are demotion, change them over to communications or termination of employment. SB 2 license to be a police officer will be removed.</p> <p>Government code 7286 any instructor that has any sustained force complaints cannot be an instructor or FTO for three years. Effective Jan. 1, 2026. Outside contracted instructor is required to report any ongoing investigation. CVPD require employee to submit if they have any outside employment (done every January). Agencies have viewing capability to see all instructor resume in POST if instructor has an sustained force complaint agency must contact they outside employment agency and inform them of the complaint and 3 year suspension of instructorship or FTO teachings.</p> <p>TNA for Major Case Training Group.
