CVPD worked with the DA's Office to develop their own training curriculum on PC 745. All sworn & civilian personnel at CVPD must take the course. Section 5 Patrick Dobbins. Matt Smith - CVPD uses the LAPD's way the V shaped. If only CVPD officers are conducting the stop, V shape is used because of the better visibility inside the car. If any other agency besides CVPD is conducting the hot stop, they revert to the Regional Academy way of teaching (stacked).</p>

4.	POST Report	<p>Earlier this year there was a subject matter expert meeting regarding POST Commission Regulation 1070 Instructor Requirement. For any 1070 course such as PSPs, Less Lethal, Chemical Agent, Motor Cycle Instructors where instructor certification is required. All POST 1070 course instructors must do an update course. POST is trying to push for next training cycle in January 2025 or most likely be January of 2027. Please keep an updated list of who your 1070 instructors are just in case you must send them in 2025. You can see 1070 list on the POST Website. 2023-14 TPRAs (ca.gov)</p> <p>POST Force Course Modification: Every July courses go into "Modification". If your course was created in an even year 2024, it will be forced into modification in two years 2026. Purpose of that is to keep instructor list updated and any changes in policy updated. Dan has a lot in his queue, he will move all PSPs to the top of his list first.</p> <p>SB-1122 POST Education Bill Modern Policing Bachelor's Degree implementing in 2029. Officer must have bachelor's degree or modern policing degree; not both. Officers must complete within 36 months upon graduating from the Academy. Bachelor's degree must be from a US Institution Training Managers are responsible to make sure officers meet this education modern policing bachelor's degree requirement. Suggestion review files each year to make sure they are on track.</p>

		<p>New Bills on Governor's desk-Pending status until November 1st. AB-1839 new bill on Governor's desk; help law enforcement up to \$6,000 to get that degree.</p> <p>AB-2042 Additional training for K9 and K9 handlers must go through periodic training.</p> <p>AB-2541 additional training for officer in the area of Alzheimer's disease, Autism and dementia.</p> <p>AB-2621 additional training in the responses to hate crimes. Specifically to LGBTQ, and Jewish communities.</p> <p>AB 3038 at least 1 armed SRO/Officers on all school campuses (every single school).</p> <p>SB 1020 (bill on desk) require each law enforcement agency and police academy to prohibit the use, as specified, of ethnic shooting targets, as defined. "Ethnic shooting target" means any physical range target that depicts a human form or part of a human form that includes skin colors or facial features from which a person might reasonably discern a race or ethnicity of the person depicted. An "ethnic shooting target" does not include a silhouette target or a human form target with a nonhuman skin color such as green or blue that does not have facial features.</p> <p>Background Investigators to use new background narrative, medical screening forms, and social media check list.
