CNOA also receives request from IPA, CNOA helps connect International Police Officers that are here on vacations and wants to trade patches or see what other stations are like. | <p>5.</p> | <p>Open Forum</p> | <p>Lea Corbin, Coronado PD; Hosting 5-day Yoga for 1st Responders (train the trainer course). Really good training for your Wellness Unit. Booked this training over a year and half ago before POST UCSD Wellness Program. The company is out of the Midwest, not from California. Please pass information along to your Fire Department Training Representatives. Will be sending out flyers soon. Coronado PD Hosting ICS 300 in January & 400 in February. Pre-requisites are ICS 100 & 200.</p> <p>Carlos Carrizosa, MiraCosta PD; Would like to have a discussion on Hot Stop training. How are your departments handling that? Whether it was being done individually or based on the 9th circuit Court of Appeals ruled that officers cannot conduct a high-risk vehicle stop, based on a reasonable suspicion that the vehicle is stolen. Sgt. Yeates will check with Academy Instructors to see how hot stop topic are being taught. To be discussed further in November's meeting.</p> <p>Melody Batuyong, SD Harbor PD; SDHPD hosting Assertive Supervision and Leadership Accountability in May 2025 at the Port of San Diego Administrative Building.</p> <p>Marisa Messier, GTA; Courses for this fiscal year are up on the website. ICI, IDI, or Management Course unsure yet this year if they will run extra sessions depending on if they have any funds left from POST cost saving contracts or if they have to return funds back. If you have people that need classes, please place them on the wait list and they will be prioritized into the next session. If you have a student that needs to be registered last minute, call GTA and see if they can squeeze them in.</p> <p>Need for additional local Supervisory Course presenters. Marisa spoke to Dan Schmitt POST Regional Representative prior to reaching out to Jim Katapodis - coordinator at POST for the Supervisory Course. Jim denied our request, because SDSO stated they can accommodate and show presentations at that time. SDSO has 2 courses per fiscal year, and each class is full. Training managers are sending students to Orange County; causing staffing, and budget constraints. SDTMA conducted a TNA May-July, 2024. 77 sergeants will need the Supervisory Course by Mid-2025.
