Law states applicants and employees that no questions can be asked and no discrimination can take place regarding for those that use marijuana recreationally. There are no exemptions for law enforcement and fire personnel. There are exemptions for agencies that are federally funded. Agencies can't screen for it when doing background. How are your agency approach when dealing with this new law; is there a game plan? Marisa Messier, GTA the HR group for San Diego County are working on the testing aspect. ~Brian Stoney, PERT. 3 Day Academy for 11/28-11/30/23 is full booked with 62 students. Next course March 19-21<sup>st</sup>, 2024 has 38 registered out of the 50 seats full. Don't wait register right away. Next class will be sometime in July.

~Ernie Gomez, Santa Ana College Criminal Justice Academy; has a partnership with Orange County Sheriffs. Will be offering Campus Law Enforcement course for Officers to become SRO to work on a school campus environment. They are hoping to get a POST approved Drone course up and going sometime in April or May, 2024 at college costs \$100/student.

AB 89 Modern Policing Degree in 2028 you have to have a bachelor's degree to become a Police Officer in California. They are going to build it through the Police Academy where the students already received 29 and half units through the academy. They are going through the Chiefs and Sheriffs Association to find out what they are planning to do. The final draft is already there. ~Juliette Barnes, Palomar College Police Academy. Their program allows the student to get a Law Enforcement Degree not just in general education in the academy. Credit for prior learning is taking your industry experience and getting college credit for it. They already have a pathway for Police Officers who wants to get their associate degree; there are no need to

		take administration of justice courses, or you don't have to take too many courses depending on the institution's framework. The CSU system accepts CPL because, it is transcribed credit on a transcript just as long it is a POST certified academy in California. Contact Juliette for more information.
